



Connecticut

In Connecticut, the food and beverage industry contributes **\$1,889,681,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs **8,227** people, and operates **302** facilities.¹

The food industry in Connecticut also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **6.7%** of total non-durable exports.²
