



Maryland

In Maryland, the food and beverage industry contributes **\$3,565,853,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs **15,420** people, and operates **331** facilities.¹

The food industry in Maryland also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **4.9%** of total non-durable exports.²
