



Michigan

In Michigan, the food and beverage industry contributes **\$5,854,480,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs at least **29,272** people, and operates **860** facilities.¹

The food industry in Michigan also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **12.3%** of total non-durable exports.²
