



New Mexico

In New Mexico, the food and beverage industry contributes at least **\$1,300,836,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs at least **7,806** people, and operates **149** facilities.¹

The food industry in New Mexico also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **43.1%** of total non-durable exports.²
