



New York

In New York, the food and beverage industry contributes at least **\$17,439,049,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs at least **103,502** people, and operates **1,884** facilities.¹

The food industry in New York also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **9.6%** of total non-durable exports.²
