



Ohio

In Ohio, the food and beverage industry contributes at least **\$25,058,451,000** per annum in value added to the economy, employs at least **110,849** people, and operates **923** facilities.¹

The food industry in Ohio also relies heavily on strong access to foreign markets, as processed foods account for approximately **8.5%** of total non-durable exports.²
